Professional Training

- *Specialization - Gastrointestinal and Liver Surgery*

During my exclusive training in GI surgery at CMC, Vellore, I had rotations in upper gastrointestinal, hepatobiliary – pancreatic and colorectal units. This ensured concentrated and repeated exposure to one particular system. I have performed and assisted in major gastrointestinal operations. I have been exposed to advanced laparoscopic procedures, including laparoscopic colorectal and esophageal operations. I have actively participated in the liver transplant programme during my residency in Christian Medical College, Vellore.

- Post-graduation – General surgery

At PGI, Chandigarh, where I pursued my general surgical residency, I was involved in managing patients with pancreatic diseases, pancreatic infections, inflammatory bowel disease and intestinal fistulae. The institution is a major tertiary referral centre in north India and the department of General Surgery



mainly deals with complex GI cases. During the same time I was exposed to shunt surgeries, portal hypertensive biliopathy and aortic surgeries. I also developed special interest in post-procedure and infected peripheral pseudoaneurysm repair.

- *Endoscopy training*

I have experience of both diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopic procedures. I had a medical gastroenterology rotation for 3 months. I have performed many diagnostic gastroscopies and colonoscopies. I have extensive experience of rigid and flexible sigmoidoscopy and assisted in many therapeutic endoscopic procedures.
